Don Zimmerman 1912 - 2011

Longtime RBR member Don Zimmerman passed away on August 20<sup>th</sup> following a brief illness. He was still riding at the age of 99. His herds included Rose Bowl Riders, Vaqueros del Desierto and the Equestrian Trails Inc. Corral 2 Board of Directors. For over 25 years Don rode patrol in the Arroyo Seco with the Pasadena Police Volunteer Mounted Unit.

### Reminders

- o Lock tack rooms when leaving the immediate vicinity. Do not borrow others equipment unless you have permission to do so.
- o Be sure your horse's stall card is posted, legible and up-to-date. Contact the Barn Manager if you need a new one.
- o Keep your stall and tack room areas neat – sweep out tack rooms and organize your belongings. Weed around your stall and rake up debris regularly.
- o Mosquito season is here –water buckets must be cleaned at least every 3 days.
