**SUBJECT: Southern California Edison (SCE) Construction Activities in Your Area:
Helicopter Activity**

Dear resident / property owner,

Southern California Edison (SCE) is currently upgrading its electrical facilities as part of SCE's Tehachapi Renewable Transmission Project (TRTP) that will deliver clean, renewable energy and traditional generation to the region and strengthen SCE's electrical system. In your area, **this includes the installation of new electrical transmission wires on existing towers**, as described below.

We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause and will make every effort to minimize potential impacts during construction activities. We appreciate your patience during construction of this important project. *Please note that residents closest to the project may have already received other notifications about this project. This letter serves as a follow-up.*

Project construction in your area (*TRTP Segment 11B*) will include the following:

1 Installation of New Electrical Transmission Wires – Helicopter Activity

- Operation of construction equipment, vehicles, helicopters, and helicopter support yards
- Maintenance of existing access roads, site preparation, and installation of wire set up sites
- Hauling and erection of electrical transmission structures
- Installation of electrical transmission wire utilizing helicopters
- Additional construction activities in compliance with the project license
- **Only one new tower will be installed next to the existing Goodrich Substation in Pasadena**

2 Project Area

- Within the existing utility right-of-way corridor along TRTP Segment 11B, including the use of approved construction roads

3 Construction Schedule

- Helicopter operations in your area **early August**, and will last approximately six weeks or more.
- Construction hours will be **Monday through Saturday starting at 7:00 a.m. through available daylight hours**, in compliance with the project license, local ordinances and regulations.
- **Note:** the construction schedule is tentative and may change depending on weather, environmental conditions and other factors outside of SCE's control. **SCE may require additional work hours, including Sunday hours.**

Tips for Minimizing Construction Impacts

SCE is committed to minimizing any inconvenience and ensuring public safety during this work. Water tankers will be utilized to help minimize dust impacts. In addition to SCE efforts to minimize the impacts to nearby residents and businesses during construction, here are some simple tips that may help you reduce construction disturbance:

- Close all windows and doors facing the construction area in order to reduce noise and dust.
