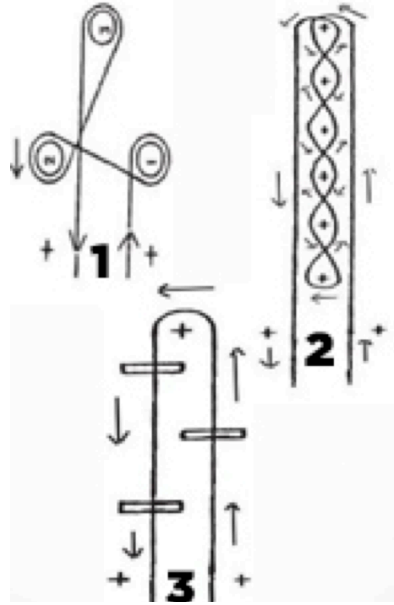
## **IT TAKES TWO** *Team Classes*

- 4. Run, Ride and Lead (2 people, 1 horse)
- 5. Paired Apple Race (2 people, 2 horses)
- 6. Paired Ribbon Ride (2 people, 2 horses)

## **SKILL** *Ability & Horsemanship*

- 7. Egg In Spoon Ride
- 8. Obstacle Course

Classes may be run right OR left



## CLASS & DIVISION DETAILS

**Cloverleaf Barrels** - Riders will guide their horses through the cloverleaf pattern (see diagram) and return to the start. Rider with the fastest time wins.

**Pole Bending** - Riders will ride to the opposite end of the arena, weave up and down through the poles and then ride back up to the start. Rider with the fastest time wins. (see diagram)

**Hurry Scurry Over Fences** - Riders will navigate their horses over a series of 3 fences and around one pole (see diagram). Rider with the fastest time and least amount of knockdowns wins.

**Run Ride and Lead** - Entrants will line up on the east side of the arena and their horses will be held on the west side. When given the signal entrants will run to meet their horses, mount up, ride back to the east side, dismount and lead their horses back to the west side. First one to the finish wins.

**Paired Apple Race** - This class involves 2 riders and 1 horse. The first rider must trot to the end of the arena, pick up an apple from the top of a barrel and trot back to their partner at the top of the arena. The first rider will then dismount and the second rider will mount the horse from the ground with the apple in hand, race to the end of the arena, place the apple back on the barrel and race back to the start. The fastest time to accomplish this task wins.

**Paired Ribbon Ride** - Each team will be given a 3ft. piece of crepe paper to hold between them. You may be asked to walk, trot, canter and back-up. The last pair still holding their "ribbon" intact, wins.

**Egg in Spoon Ride** - The rider will hold an egg in a spoon while riding their horse in the arena. Rider may hold onto the egg until instructed to remove their thumb from the egg. From that point on, the rider must have their hand behind the black line on the spoon and may not touch the egg, hold their thumb over the egg, or hold their fingers under the bowl of the spoon. When asked to change gaits, the rider must do so immediately.

**Obstacle Course** - Riders must pick up rope tied to a log from 1st barrel, drag log behind the horse to second barrel and replace rope. Then proceed to closest orange cone, pick up egg, ride to next cone and place egg on top and repeat. After last cone turn and run home. This is a timed class.

## **CLASS RULES & FAQs**

- U **One class FREE if you wear your RBR T-shirt**
- U Riders under 18 must wear an ATSM/SEI approved riding helmet while mounted.
- U **ALL** riders over fences must wear an ATSM/SEI approved riding helmet.
- U Age groups will be pinned separately if entries warrant.
- U “Broomstick Horses” will be supplied to those entering on foot.
- U Alcoholic beverages and smoking are not allowed anywhere on the RBR premises.
- U Dogs shall be kept on a leash and under control at all times. Dogs may not be tied to tie rails. The following breeds are not permitted on the premises: Rottweiler, Pit Bull Terrier, Doberman, Akita, Chow & mixed breeds thereof.
- U All exhibitors and their guardians must sign an ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT.
- U **All riders, trainers & parents are expected to exhibit good sportsmanship.**
